#### **Fireplace Safety**

• Keep your fireplace clean. It is recommended that you have your chimney cleaned professionally once a year.



- Cover your fireplace with a screen.
- Papers and other materials can escape while burning and ignite. Only burn wood in your fireplace.
- Make sure the fire is completely extinguished before leaving the room.

#### **Spacer Heater Safety**

- Keep heater out of walking paths.
- Keep away from children and pets.
- Place away from beds.



- Make sure newspapers, magazines and any fabrics, including curtains, sheets and tablecloths, are not within three feet of a space heater.
- Unplug when not in use.

#### MLGW's 2013 Budget Approved

The Memphis City Council has approved MLGW's 2013 budget. The \$1.8 billion budget includes a modest water rate increase, and a temporary gas rate decrease that more than offsets the water rate increase for the average city water customer. The budget also includes the expansion of MLGW's smart meter project.

The water rate increase of 7.1 percent will increase the average city residential water customer's bill by 98 cents per month (\$11.76 per year). However, a temporary gas rate decrease from January - March 2013 would provide an average credit of approximately \$13.01 per customer, eliminating any negative impact from the water rate increase. The rate adjustments will take effect on January 1, 2013.

Despite the water rate increase, MLGW President Jerry Collins Jr. said, "MLGW will continue to have one of the cheapest water supplies in the nation."

#### **Project Care: Ist Annual Race to Care**

MLGW's first annual Race to CARE 5K Run/Walk, held at Shelby Farms, was a great success with more than 1,400 MLGW employees donating \$38,621.00. More than 500 people signed up for the 5K race, and 60 volunteered during the event.

Funds raised from the event will benefit the Project CARE Customer Assistance Program, which is designed to help MLGW customers reduce their energy consumption by providing the necessary capital and labor to make minor repairs to their primary residence. Project CARE will be able to assist more than 150 customers with the \$72,000 that has been raised so far.
