PRESIDENT'S BRIEFING (Continued):

2. Other - <u>Jerry R. Collins, Jr.</u> asked Michael Taylor, Nick Newman, Alonzo Weaver and Gale Carson to report on their areas.

Michael Taylor gave an update for the Customer Care area. He discussed the different programs available at this time. The winter moratorium is available for the elderly and disabled

starting December 1 through March 1 and currently there are 257 customers on that program. The holiday bill break is available for customers having a balance of \$399 or less. He discussed extremely cold temperatures and how cut-offs are managed. There have been approximately 200 calls due to burst water pipes. MLGW cuts the water off at the meter.

<u>Nick Newman</u> gave an update for Construction & Maintenance. He stated there have been a few outages during the holiday due to a primary wire that was down. Additional outages were caused by a squirrel getting into the substation and outages caused by gun shots on New Year's Eve. The most impacted division is the water distribution system. He explained how extreme cold temperatures cause the ground to free and as the thawing begins, water mains break. There are 18 crews working 16 hours a day keeping up with the calls.

Alonzo Weaver discussed the increased volume of natural gas used during extremely cold temperatures. TVA issued an electric power supply alert. When needed, TVA will send out alerts for Step 10 and Step 20 which can be issued separately or simultaneously.

Gale Carson distributed a handout to the Board which included a list of various programs available to assist the customers financially, conserving energy, safety tips and many other beneficial factors. Gale noted that based on her research and comparisons to other utility companies, MLGW greatly exceeds any and everything they offer to their customers.
