PRESIDENT'S BRIEFING

President McGowen acknowledged Commissioner Graves' nomination by President Trump to serve on the TVA Board. President McGowen spoke of Commissioner Graves work on the MLGW Board and stated that many local utility companies were excited about Commissioner Graves nomination. President McGowen mentioned that today's Board Meeting was short, but stated not to be worried as at the next few meetings he will be bringing several items to continue our grid modernization, information on the facilities needed to house our control room and making a decision on that, and information on our solar and battery RFPs, including where we are on that and the responses we have received. President McGowen also stated we will also be getting into Budget Season, so there is lots of work happening. President McGowen mentioned our summer boot camps that are offered to eleventh and twelfth grade high school students in the Memphis/Shelby County School System. President McGowen stated that we had 58 students participate this year in our Utility Worker Boot Camp, Automotive Technology Boot Camp, and our Customer Service Academy. President McGowen stated that we hope to offer something in the IT Field next year. President McGowen stated that these boot camps are really about building a workforce in our community. President McGowen recognized Councilwoman Cooper-Sutton for being instrumental in the success of the Customer Service Academy this year. President McGowen also recognized the Superintendent of the Memphis/Shelby County Schools for attending the graduation for these students from our boot camps. A video that was created by our partner, Southwest Community College was shown that displayed the opportunities and experiences these students had because of these boot camps.
