# Survey History

The largest three-service municipal utility system in the nation, MLGW delivers electricity, natural gas and water throughout Memphis and Shelby County. Each year we strive to not only deliver the best possible price, but also the highest quality service.

We surveyed 39 cities, including many that are geographically close to Memphis, as well as utilities that are similar in size to MLGW. All costs covered in this survey are based on published rates effective January 2022.

MLGW started collecting data on rates in 1991. Memphis continues to outperform many cities in terms of what customers pay for electricity, natural gas and water services. MLGW's financial management remains a driving force in keeping utility bills as low as possible.



## Memphis: 10 Years Among Lowest Winter Utility Bills

Historically, Memphis customers have spent less for their winter utility bills than their counterparts in many metro areas, capturing the top ranking 18 times since 1991. The 2022 ranking includes what a homeowner would pay for 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of electricity, 200 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of gas and 10 CCF of water. Wastewater is no longer included. Dollar amounts have been rounded.

# ELECTRICITY



MLGW buys electricity from the Tennessee Valley Authority. TVA sells its power on a non-profit basis to 153 local power companies. As TVA's largest customer, MLGW purchases 10 percent of TVA's power.

MLGW owns and maintains over 1,000 miles of transmission lines and four connection points or substations with TVA. The utility company is capable of meeting peak system demands of up to 3.6 million kilowatts for its 440,000 electric customers.

In 2021, the American Public Power Association's Reliable Public Power Provider program gave MLGW its highest ranking – Diamond level status – which lasts for three years.



# NATURAL GAS

MLGW currently buys natural gas and moves it via three interstate pipeline companies, Texas Gas Transmission Corp., ANR Pipeline Co. and Trunkline Gas Co. MLGW supplies 316,000 gas customers with 30 billion cubic feet of gas a year purchased from more than 30 suppliers.

In addition to natural gas, MLGW also operates a wholesale Liquefied Natural Gas facility and two retail Compressed Natural Gas stations for our customers.















# Annual Average Residential Price per Kilowatt-Hour (kWh) of Electricity





Figure 1 displays a comparison of MLGW annual average residential price of electricity (\$/kWh) vs. US annual average residential price of electricity (\$/kWh) from 2001 – 2021. During these years, MLGW has provided cheaper rates than national average. According to 2021 prices, an MLGW typical residential annual bill (13,890 kWh) was approximately \$434 less than US typical residential annual bill. # Annual Average Residential Price per Thousand Cubic Feet (MCF) of Natural Gas



Figure 2 displays a comparison of MLGW annual average residential price of natural gas (\$/MCF) vs. US annual average residential price of gas (\$/MCF) from 2001 – 2021. MLGW continues to deliver cheaper natural gas to residential customers than national average. According to 2021 prices, an MLGW typical residential annual bill (70 MCF) was approximately \$288 less than US typical residential annual bill. US annual average price data in Figure 2 is generated by US Energy Information Administration (EIA), sampling 323 of the largest US gas utilities. # Annual Average Residential Price per Hundred Cubic Feet (CCF) of Water




Figure 3 displays a comparison of MLGW annual average residential price of water (\$/CCF) vs. US annual average residential price of water (\$/CCF) from 2001 – 2021. MLGW has delivered high quality drinking water to residential customers at cheaper rates than national average. According to 2021 prices, an MLGW typical residential annual bill (94 CCF) was approximately \$204 less than US typical residential annual bill.
